Additional Precautionary Measures for 2020 Term 2

In view of the current COVID-19 situation, MOE has announced that schools will implement additional precautionary measures to further mitigate the chance of disease transmission.

The following additional measures will take place when school re-opens on Monday 23 March:

A. Additional Social Distancing Measures

- All CCA sessions and after-school programmes (including remedial lessons, E2K, SDR, RRP and enrichment lessons) will be suspended in Term 2 Weeks 1 & 2, i.e. from 23 Mar to 3 Apr.
- As a result of CCA suspension, dismissal on Wednesdays (that is, 25 Mar and 1 Apr) for all levels will be at 1 p.m. Primary 3-6 pupils will receive the non-CCA Timetable by 24 March.
- Singapore Youth Festival Arts Presentation would be deferred in Term 2 Weeks 1 & 2.
- The National School Games will continue to be suspended until the end of the June holidays.
- Fixed exam-style seating for P3-6 students, and fixed group cluster seating for P1/2 students.

B. <u>Personal Hygiene and Social Responsibility</u>

- Please remind your child/ward to continue to bring a working ODT (Oral Digital Thermometer) for daily temperature taking. Do replace the batteries or buy a new ODT if necessary.
- Daily wipe-down for tables used by students in the classroom (and whenever somebody else uses the table). Please ensure that your child/ward brings his/her own tissue or cloth and the school will provide the diluted liquid detergent.
- If your child/ward is unwell, please do not send him/her to school and seek immediate medical treatment. All students who are unwell and exhibit symptoms of flu will be asked to be brought home by parents/caregivers.

C. Visitor Management

- All visitors will need to report to the security guard post and fill in a travel declaration form, before entering the school premises. Temperature screening will also be conducted for visitors.
- Visitors who have travelled overseas and returned to Singapore (regardless of country or mode of entry) on 14 March 2020 or later will not be allowed to enter the school for 14 days upon their return to Singapore.
- For the safety and well-being of all, we seek your understanding and cooperation.

D. School Dismissal

 For your own safety and well-being, please do NOT come too early to pick up your child/ward from school, try to arrive just in time instead, to avoid crowding outside the school gate. After picking up your child/ward, kindly leave the area immediately.

MOE and the school will continue to keep parents informed of updates. We would like to take this opportunity to advise parents who are on-board Parents Gateway, to remain logged-in to the app at all times. This would allow you to receive notifications when school or MOE post announcements.
